She was appointed as a full-time judge in 2012. Before that she was at the criminal bar, practising in all types of criminal cases mostly across London and the South-Eastern Circuit. She was appointed a Bencher of Gray's Inn in 2009.

She was a Recorder between 2009 and 2012, being appointed a QC in 2010. She was appointed to the Central Criminal Court from 27th February 2017. Prior to that date she sat as a full-time judge at the Crown Court at Woolwich. Between 2018 and 2023 she sat as an occasional judge in the Court of Appeal Criminal Division.

She has been a judicial member of the Judicial Appointments Commission since June 2018. She is a Tutor Judge for the Judicial College and was appointed as a Diversity and Community Relations Judge in 2023. Anuja is a Liveryman of the Haberdashers' Company.
