As a barrister he specialised in crime, practising in London and the South-East, being appointed a QC in 1999. He was made a Bencher of the Inner Temple in 2002. A Recorder from 2000, he became a peripatetic class one judge across the South-Eastern Circuit in 2009 and went to Southwark Crown Court in 2011.

He was appointed a Senior Circuit Judge at the Central Criminal Court in April 2017. From 2013 he has sat as an occasional judge in the Court of Appeal Criminal Division. In 2012 he was appointed Chancellor of the Diocese of Ely and Commissary to the Archbishop of Canterbury.
