

His Honour Judge Nigel Lickley KC

Nigel Lickley was appointed a full-time judge in 2018. Before that he was a barrister in practice at the criminal bar. His practice was in all types of criminal cases mostly on the Western Circuit. He was appointed a QC in 2006.

He was leader of the Western Circuit between 2010 and 2013. He was an Assistant Recorder from 1998 to 2000, and a Recorder between 2000 and 2018. He was Head of Chambers at 3 Paper Buildings between 2015 and 2018. He was appointed a Bencher of Gray's Inn in 2011.

He was appointed to the Central Criminal Court with effect from 10th December 2018. He was appointed as a Deputy High Court Judge in 2018. Since 2023 he has sat as an occasional judge in the Court of Appeal Criminal Division. He is a Tutor Judge for the Judicial College. Nigel is a Freeman of the Cutlers' Company.
