

Her Honour Judge Sarah Munro KC

She was appointed a full-time judge in 2011. Before that she was a barrister in practice at the criminal bar. Her practice was in all types of criminal cases mostly across the Western Circuit. She was appointed a QC in 2002. She was appointed as a Bencher of the Inner Temple in 2016.

She was a Recorder between 2000 and 2011. She was appointed to the Central Criminal Court with effect from 31st July 2017. Prior to that date she sat as a full-time judge at the Crown Court at Portsmouth. Since 2013 she has sat as an occasional judge in the Court of Appeal Criminal Division.

She was a judicial member of the Sentencing Council from 2013 to [date]. She is a Course Director and Tutor Judge for the Judicial College. She is a member of the Judicial Board of Archbold: Criminal Pleading, Evidence & Practice. She is also an Assistant Coroner for East London. In July 2022 she made legal history as the first judge to be broadcast passing sentence. Sarah is a Liveryman of the Ironmongers' Company.

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
