To the Liverymen of the City of London

My Lords, Ladies and Gentlemen,

Encouraged by many friends in the Livery and on Common Council and supported by the Master, Wardens and Court of The Worshipful Company of Cutlers, I offer myself as a candidate for the High Office of Sheriff of the City of London at the election to be held in Common Hall at Guildhall on Monday 26 June 2006 at TWELVE NOON. I invite you to use one of your two votes in support of me and the other in support of Alderman David Lewis.

I was educated at Wimbledon College and began my career in the City with the Prudential Assurance Company qualifying as a Chartered Secretary in the Investment Department. In 1964 I moved from active fund management to the Association of British Insurers where I specialised in the development of emerging markets, financial derivatives, corporate reconstructions and promoting London on behalf of institutional investors as the leading financial market in the world. I also served on a number of senior Committees of the Bank of England, Treasury and CBI in London, Paris and Brussels, and until 2001 was a member of the International Board of the Paris Bourse, developing the Nouveau Marché.

I was Master of the Worshipful Company of Cutlers in 2002-2003 and am an active member of two Past Masters' Associations. I was elected to the Court of Common Council eight years ago and have served as: Chairman of Community Services Committee; Deputy Chairman of Governors of the City of London School for Girls and King Edward's School Witley; and Deputy Chairman of the Standards Committee of the Corporation of London. I also serve on the Policy and Resources Committee and the Livery Committee; am an Almoner of Christ's Hospital; a Governor of the Guildhall School of Music and Drama; and a Trustee of the City Almshouses. I am a life Governor of the Sheriffs' and Recorder's Fund; a Member of Council of the City of London Branch of the Royal Society of St George; and a member of the City Livery Club and Farringdon Ward Clubs.

My wife Anne is a Liveryman of the Worshipful Company of Fletchers and a committee member of the ladies' groups of my two Past Masters' Associations. Both she and I have taken an active role in the past few years in the City of London Red Cross Christmas Market. I am delighted to have the full support of Anne and our family in my City and civic careers.

If elected to the High Office of Sheriff, I believe my experience in and commitment to the City of London will enable me to discharge fully its duties and responsibilities, both in the Central Criminal Court and, as a member of the Civic team, in supporting the Lord Mayor as he promotes the United Kingdom and City's financial pre-eminence worldwide.
